		<p>In order to participate in a competition, athletes <b>MUST</b> be present in school for a <u>full</u> day the day of the competition. Any exceptions to this rule must be approved by an administrator (principal, activities director), and include situations such as appointments made in advance, family emergencies, etc.</p>
		<p>Eligibility will be determined every Monday. In order to be eligible for competition, the athlete must have at least a 2.0 GPA. This status will remain in effect until the next Monday.</p> <p>Per MHS A policy, if a student is not passing a minimum of four classes at the end of a semester, he/she is ineligible for participation at any level in any MHS A-sanctioned activity during the subsequent semester.</p>
		<p>Per SHS Policy, parents will not communicate with the coach regarding a game, or situation in a game, within 24 hours of a competition, or this may result in the athlete not playing in the next game.</p>
		<p>If there is an issue with play time, play calls, or other student athletes, the athlete must discuss it with the coach prior to the parents getting involved. If it is unable to be resolved in this manner, the parent may make an appointment to discuss it with the coach, adhering to the 24-hour rule.</p>
