What health care services are covered by HMK?

Children can get the following services:

- office visits and well-child checkups emergency care
 - physicals for sports and jobs
 - immunizations/shots
 - dental visits
- vision exams and eyeglasses hearing exams & hearing aids
 - hospital care
- prescription drugs

- lab and x-ray services mental health services
- substance abuse services
- and more

What's the Healthy Montana Kids Plan?

The Healthy Montana Kids Plan (HMK) offers low-cost or free health coverage for children up to age 19.

Children may qualify for HMK if:

- the children are Montana residents,
 U.S. citizens or qualified aliens; and
- family income meets income guidelines based on family size.

For some families, depending on income:

there may be an enrollment delay if the child is currently insured.





Children and teenagers, who get regular checkups (and treatment for health problems) when they are growing up, do better in school and are more likely to become healthy adults.

MONTANA

What's the cost?

- There are small co-payments for some families.
- No family pays more than \$215 a year in co-payments.
- There are no co-payments for well-child checkups, immunizations, dental visits or eyeglasses.
- Families pay no monthly premiums or deductibles.



There are no co-payments for Native American children covered by HMK and they may receive services from any participating provider, including IHS and Tribal Health providers.
